

How to import the Pupil Premium Download file into Integris

An updated Pupil Premium Download file is now ready for download from the new **Get Information About Pupils** (GIAP) site via the DfE Sign-in Gateway.

The information within this file can be imported into Integris to update your pupil records with the most recent information held by the DfE regarding the pupils for whom your school is allocated Pupil Premium funding for [financial year 2021/2022](#). (More detail about content of PP download csv file is shown on p.2).

The Pupil Premium funding will be identified in the following categories:

- Deprivation Pupil Premium – *has been eligible or was eligible for FSM as at 1st October 2020 census*
- Service Child Premium
- Post Looked After Premium
- Looked After Premium (only if pupil was/is also FSM eligible)

Note: Pupils recorded as LAC only and EYPP (nursery) pupils will NOT be included in this file as the funding for these pupils is directed to the LA and not schools).

Download the PP file from GIAP website

1. Access the **GIAP** portal via the **DfE Sign-in** gateway in the normal way.
2. On the GIAP portal, locate and click the link **Pupil Premium 2021-2022** to access the PP web page
3. You should now find a link called '**pp2122_laestab_1.csv**' where 'laestab' is your school's 7 digit LA_estab number and '1' identifies the file as being the summer download.

BE CAREFUL NOT TO NOT OPEN THE CSV FILE AT THIS POINT!

4. Depending on the browser you are using: Left click on the link and select Save Link As... or Right Click on the link to select Save Link As... or Save Target As.... - these steps should NOT open the csv file –

and select to save the csv file in a folder that you can locate easily in the next step.

5. You can now log out of GIAP and DfE Sign-in gateway and continue immediately to the next step!

Import the Pupil Premium csv file details into your Integris

1. In Integris, go to **Administration > Import & Export > Pupil Premium Import**
2. Select the csv file you previously downloaded and saved and click **Next**

At this point, Integris will check the format of the file to ensure it is as expected – if you see a message saying that the file is in an incorrect format, it is because you have opened the file when downloading it in step 4 above. Delete this downloaded file and go back to GIAP and re-download the file without opening it.

3. After validation is complete, the next screen confirms the filename and the type of file. Click **Next** to import the file.

Note: details will only be imported where there is a matched UPN and no previous record of the same eligibility dates.

4. The final summary screen confirms the details of the import.

CHECKING

The next steps enable you to check that the FSM pupils or current PP pupils **you are expecting to receive funding for have a new Pupil Premium Grant entry for 2021/2022**.

List of pupils with PP Grant allocation for 2021/22

1. Go to **Reports > Administration > Student Reports > Pupil Premium Grants**
2. In the **For any date in:** box, change to **Selected School Year**
3. In the **School Year** box, select **2021/2022**
(21/22 is available if you have set up the next academic year in your School Diary as part of the Year end process – otherwise you need to put in a selected date range of 1/4/21 – 31/3/22)
4. Select how you want the pupils to be grouped by in the **Select students by** box - e.g. Year group or by class – or if you have used the **School Defined Pupil Premium** field, then change to **Student Find** > click **+** > click **Additional Info** tab > select **True** in the **School Defined Pupil Premium** box > click **Find** > click **Select** and click **Yes** to the prompt
5. Click the **Sorts** tab and remove the tick for **Page** if you do not want each year or class printed on a separate page.
6. Click hand icon to select all years/classes/pupils in the list
7. Click **Generate Report**

Note: new FSM pupils with PP Grants starting from 1/4/2021 will now be flagged with the PP  icon in addition to the FSM  icon. *If this has not occurred, please let CBICT admin know!*

WHO ARE YOUR FSM PUPILS WITHOUT A PP GRANT?

Print list of FSM pupils without a Pupil Premium Grant (where FSM Start date is AFTER 1st Oct 2020 or where a pupil has joined your school after 1st Oct 2020)

Best way to do this is to use Speed Edit and print from there:

Go to **Modules > Administration > Speed Edit** > under **Area**, select **FSM Entitlement Start** > click **Find** >

In **Search** window, click on **Additional Info** tab

> for **Entitlement to FSM** select **True** AND for the **Pupil Premium Grant** line, change to **Any Pupil Premium Does Not apply in any year**

> click **Find** > click **Select** and click **Yes** to the prompt.

You should now see list of pupils who were either eligible for FSM after 1st October 2020 OR joined your school after 1st October 2020 with an FSM date earlier than 1/10/21. These pupils will be allocated PP Grant in the next financial year from 1st April 2022.

(You can sort the list by FSM start date order or keep in name order and you can print off this list as a record).

Note: If any of these pupils without a PP Grant should have a grant for 21/22 according to their FSM date and entry date to your school, please get in touch with the DfE helpdesk directly by emailing

After importing the PP file you can also open this file to check the list of PP pupils:

After successfully importing your PP csv file into Integris, you can open the **pp2122_laestab_1.csv** file separately to check the list of pupils is as expected.

Please remember that new pupils added to the FSM register after the **1st October 2020** census reference date will NOT be included in this year's PP grant allocations but will carry forward to the next financial year.

A '1' in the Deprivation, Service Child, Adopted and Looked After columns represents 'Yes'

The 'LASTFSM' column shows the census when the pupil was most recently recorded as eligible for FSM.

(In Integris, if any of these pupils have gone onto the FSM register for the first time before 1st October 2020, they will have the PP flag switched on after the file is imported.)

The PP Cash amount column indicates the individual funding amounts for each pupil identified as '1'.
