BLW = Below the standard of the pre-key stage, PK1 = Pre Key Stage Standard 1, PK2 = Pre Key Stage Standard 2, PK3 = Pre Key Stage Standard 3, PK4 = Pre Key Stage Standard 4, PK5 = Pre Key Stage Standard 5, PK6 = Pre Key Stage Standard 6, WTS = Working towards the expected standard for most 11-year-olds, EXS = Working at the expected standard for most 11-year-olds, GDS = Working at greater depth at the expected standard for most 11-year-olds, HNM = Has not met the required standard for most 11-year-olds, A = Absent, D = Disapplied, L = Left, F = Pupil will take test in the future, P = Pupil has taken test in the past, Q = Maladministration.

#### Test Outcome

A = Absent, B = Working below the level of the test, L = Left, M = Missing, U = Unable to access test, J = Recently arrive in the school, F = Pupil will take test in the future, P = Pupil has taken test in the past, H = Pupil cheating, Q = Maladministration, AS = Achieved Standard, NS = Not achieved Standard.

#### Scaled Score

A scaled score of 100 represents the expected standard for each test. If your child gets a scaled score of 100 or more it means they are working at or above the expected standard in the subject. If your child gets a scaled score of less than 100 or an 'N' means that they may need more support to reach the expected standard. The highest scaled score possible is 120, and the lowest is 80.
