Stage 2A covers the following:


Checking/Editing KS1 TA data within the **Y2 Objectives Termly** markbooks for **Reading**, **Writing & Maths** (in the EoY2 TA unit).

Note: TA judgements should be made using the 'pupil can' statements in the 2018/19 KS1 Teacher Assessment Framework. Pupils working below the national curriculum standard should be assessed against the Pre KS1 'pupil can' statements in the Pre-KS1 TA Framework.

1. Complete your end of year objectives <u>as normal</u> in the **EoY2 Obj** unit within the Y2 Objectives Termly markbooks for Reading, Writing & Maths.

The example used here is the Y2 Maths Objectives Termly markbook

Markbook - Y2 Maths Objectives Termly - Class 2A (2015/2016)




2. When you have completed the objectives columns, open the EoY2 Average unit - please check the Average Points and Average Category outcomes that appear in the EoY2 Average unit in each of the Y2 Read, Writ & Maths Objectives markbooks.

The calculated average points will form the basis for the KS1 TA data that will be returned to the DfE.

If you disagree with the calculated average outcome for one or some of the pupils, you will be able to change them in the next steps

3. Open the last blue unit called **EoY2 TA**. This unit contains three columns – the first two are the EoY2 TA Pts (which you can edit) and a corresponding EoY2 TA Cat.



The third column is the KS1 TA column will be used to report results to the DfE.


When the EoY2 TA Pts column (highlighted in blue) is populated manually or with a copy of the Average points, then the EoY2 TA Cat column displays the outcomes. This in turn auto-populates last KS1 TA column. (See Appendix 1)




- 4. We are now going to copy the data from the EoY2 Av Pts column (in the EoY2 Average unit) to the EoY2 TA Pts column:
 - > Left click on the **EoY2 Av Pts** column header to view a pop-up menu
 - > Select the option Copy Column Values to another Column



- 5. You should now find the EoY2 TA Pts column populated with a copy of the data from the EoY2 Av Pts column. You will also see:
 - 1. The EoY2 TA Cat column shows the same category outcomes as the EoY2 Av Cat
 - 2. The KS1 TA column now contains the corresponding KS1 outcome codes (as per the conversion table in Annex 1)
- 6. At this point, please look carefully at the EoY2 TA Points/TA Category columns.

To make any changes to the KS1 TA outcome column, simply replace the points value in the EoY2 TA Pts column with a new entry and click *Calculate* and/or *Save* to see the amended EoY2 TA Cat and KS1 TA outcome.



In this example, for the second pupil listed, a 2.4 entry has been replaced with a **2.2** in the EoY2 TA Pts column.

The corresponding **Y2 Emrg** now appears in the EoY2 *TA Cat* column AND the KS1 *EXS* outcome has changed to **WTS**.

To record a D (Disapplied) or an A for a pupil, simply enter it into the EoY2 TA Pts column.

- 7. Make any changes to the TA Pts column as required and click **Save** regularly.
- To exit out of the markbook, press the BACK button (bottom left of screen) to return to the My Markbooks list.
- Repeat from step 2 above for Writing in the Y2 Writ Objectives Termly and for Reading in the Y2 Read Objectives Termly markbooks

Remember that if you have a KS1 Outcomes of **BLW** for a pupil, you will need to enter PScales values into the NC P Scales 2019 markbook – see Appendix 1

When all the KS1 TA data outcomes have been completed and checked for Reading, Writing & Maths, please follow Stage 2B - Enter KS1 Science data

The *EoY2 Av Pts* points copied to the **EoY2 TA Pts** column automatically converts to the corresponding KS1 TA value as indicated above (*in the last KS1 TA column in each of your Y2 Reading, Writing & Maths Objectives markbooks*). For example, an EoY2 TA of **2.2** points/**Y2 Emerging** category automatically converts to a KS1 value of **WTS** in the KS1 TA column in the markbook.

Please note!! The KS1 TA outcome can only be changed by changing the points in the EoY2 TA Pts column.
